



## **AANR Northwest Scholarship for AANR Northwest Students**

### **Purpose**

AANR Northwest may award a \$1000 scholarship annually to a qualified recipient who shows particular promise that higher education will enable the student to realize his/her full potential and reach his/her goals. The award is based on merit alone with no reference to financial need, sex, race or religion.

### **Eligibility and Scholastic Requirements**

At the date of application:

1. The student, the student's parent(s) or grandparent(s), must be current AANR-NW members.
2. Only students enrolled full time or part time in any United States 2 or 4 year college/university or technical/trade school will be considered.
3. Grades: a 3.0 or better cumulative GPA or a SAT score of 1200 or better.
4. Students must be high school graduates or have obtained a GED. All high school seniors or college students who start and conclude their higher education before age 30 are eligible for this scholarship.

### **Instructions to Students**

1. The Scholarship Application Request Form can be requested by e mail at:

2. Complete and return the application. Ask your AANR Northwest club official to complete the questionnaire and return to the scholarship chairperson no later than May 1. (The entry is not complete until a certified copy of your school records, the application form and the AANR-NW Club Certifying Officer Questionnaire are returned.)
3. Request a certified copy of your school records be sent to:

4. The scholarship winner will be notified by June 1 and his/her name will be announced at the AANR Northwest Convention in July of the same year.
5. All scholarship monies shall be paid directly to the college, university or technical or trade school of the student's choice.
6. If the recipient fails to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college, university, technical or trade school of the student's choice, the scholarship will be awarded to the runner-up. (If there is no runner-up, the money remains in the AANR Northwest General Fund.)
